31%

of <u>tornadoes in 2022</u> were in Mississippi, Alabama and Texas, due in part to rising temperatures in the Gulf of Mexico.

66%

of known <u>tornado-related fatalities</u> in 2023 occurred in Dixie Alley, where population density is high.
